Hot on the heels of KWS Extase, from our French breeding programme comes, KWS Equipe – with all the great attributes growers love about Extase with better grain, high yields, and great untreated yield.

KWS Equipe is the off spring of KWS Extase crossed with French market leading variety, Chevignon. It is a high yielding wheat that performs especially well in the west thanks to its excellent disease package including a 6.7 for *Septoria*.

With untreated yields at 90% treated controls, KWS Equipe is a very resilient wheat.


We would recommend that, like KWS Extase, growers do not drill KWS Equipe until the 1st week in October to maximise yield potential. At 96cm tall, the variety is a few cm taller than KWS Extase and would benefit from a good PGR programme.

So if you like how KWS Extase performed on your farm and are looking for a consistent performer no matter a dry or more challenging season, then take a closer look at KWS Equipe – like KWS Extase but with better disease resistance and grain quality.






KWS Equipe is now on the 2025/26 recommended list as a UKFM group 2 wheat. The variety showed similar analytical quality to the KWS Extase control with good loaf volumes making it a god addition to the group 2 sector.

KWS EQUIPE - Sowing for Peak Performance

80% of your crop's potential is locked in by the seed you buy and sow. While you can fine tune this with the correct nitrogen levels, using fungicides wisely to protect it from disease and paying attention to basic management principles, many attributes of your crop can't be changed. Therefore, it pays for you and your agronomist to make proactive choices before ordering a variety.

To get peak performance from KWS Equipe we recommend drilling in the following time window:
