## KWS VIBE

Group 1 Winter Wheat  
(Bernstein x KWS Zyatt)



- New high quality breadmaking wheat

**Get with the Vibe!** KWS Vibe is an exciting, high quality breadmaking wheat that has one of the best combinations of yield, disease resistance and grain quality, offering real change and excellent gross margin potential for professional milling wheat growers in all regions of the UK.

KWS Vibe is a recommended Group 1 variety and has achieved Group 1 ratings over contrasting seasons thanks to its higher proteins and gluten quality than current Group 1 controls. Couple this with higher HFN (294) and specific weights (78.6kg/hl) than KWS Zyatt and you have an exciting wheat for the future.

In the North, KWS Vibe's slow development but ability to tiller, along with a score of 6 for eyespot resistance, makes it the ideal wheat to start drilling early, a key requirement

for growers further north. In addition, the variety delivers some of the highest yields compared to current Group 1 wheats on the current RL in this region, giving growers access to premium market opportunities where available.

In the AHDB East and West, KWS Vibe is all about yield, market potential, disease resistance and field performance. It's a short stiff plant type – with 0% lodging in the challenging year of 2023 and now scores 1% with and without PGR. It has an impressive set of disease resistance scores including [7] for mildew, 8 for yellow rust and 6.5 for *Septoria*. All this and yields ahead of Skyfall and Crusoe, making KWS Vibe one of the most profitable wheats you could grow this season.

**So for drilling 2026, why not get with the Vibe!**








## KWS VIBE yield performance



At KWS, we believe to get the best performance on your farm it is critical that when you choose your variety, you are using a wealth of data to tailor your choice for both your farm and individual field situation.


